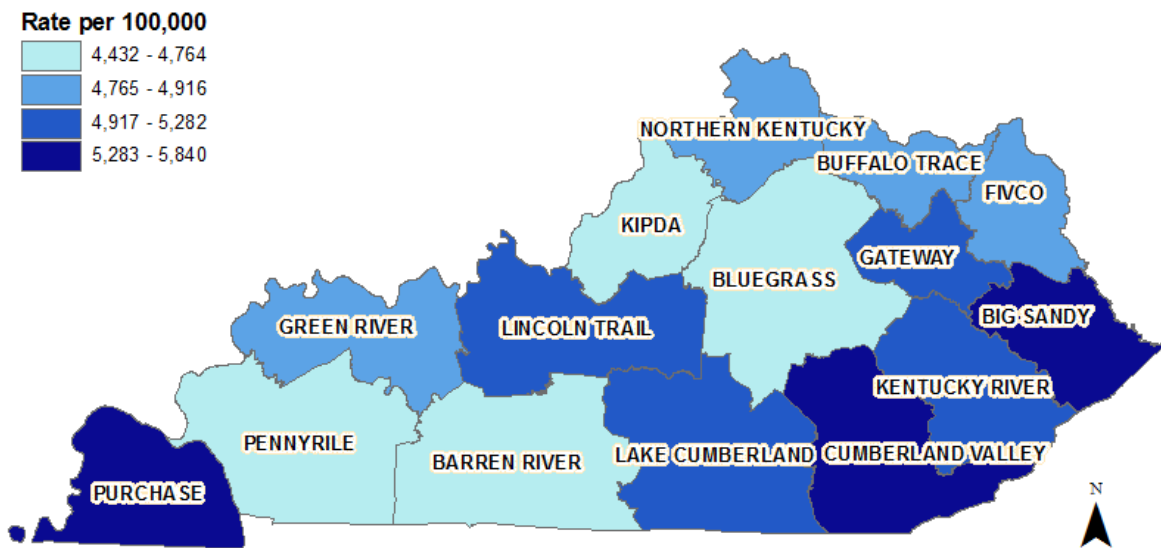

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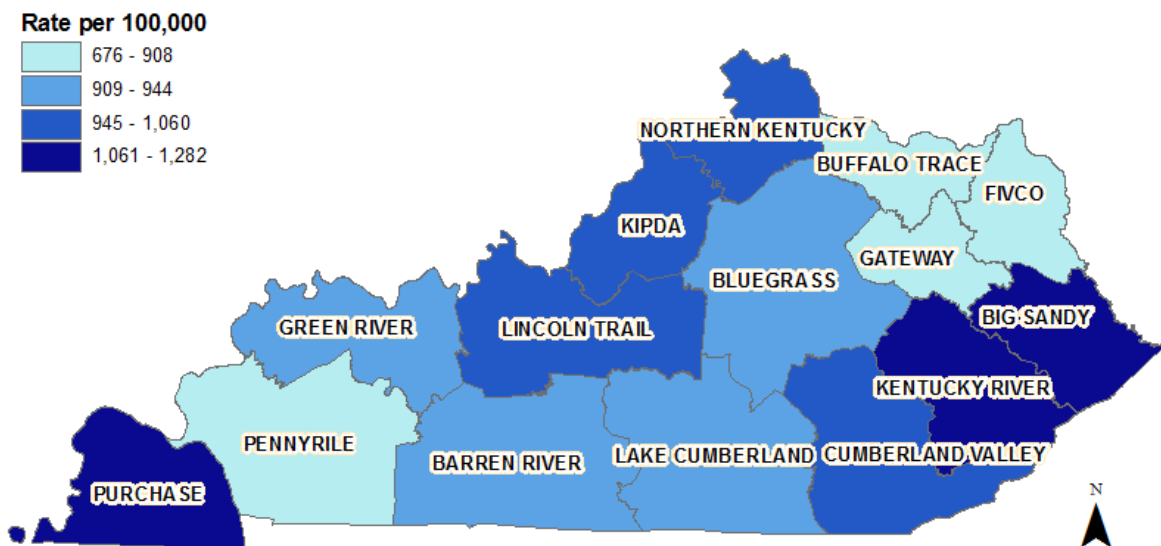
Fall-Related Emergency Department Visit Rates by Area Development District among Kentucky Residents 60 Years Old and Older, 2016
