







## Preventing Construction Falls through SKYLIGHTS and ROOF OPENINGS



Death or serious injury can result if floor holes or skylights are not guarded properly. Remember to:

|   |   |
|---|---|
|  | Cover floor holes immediately; mark cover 'HOLE' or 'COVER'.  |
|  | Ensure covers can support 2x the weight of workers and equipment.   |
|  | Notify your supervisor of unguarded floor holes or skylights.   |
|  | Use covers or screens, railing or guardrails, or a personal fall arrest system when working around skylights and floor hole openings. |
|  | Never sit on, lean against, or step on any skylight or covered hole.  |
|  | Never start a job without required fall protection in place.  |
