 Founded in 1993, by a coalition by Terrie Williams, MSW

- Medical, Social Services & Advocacy rooted in harm reduction practice, le by those with lived experience
- 15,000 points of service at 4 locations and extensive mobile services
- People who do sex work, people who use opioids and/or stimulants, unhoused LGBTQ+ community

Sex

Sex work is the consensual provision of sexual services between adults. It acknowledges this form of labor, contextualizes within labor rights models

Transactional

acknowledges "gig' economy and non traditional forms of resource sharing Also encompasses non commercial forms of exchange - food, shelter, protection

focuses on the act of exchange, not identity

Trafficking

Usually stands to mean force, fraud or coercion, but also any exchange by someone under 18. Ignores circumstances, legally and culturally vague

Sexual

Identifies abuse of a position of vulnerability, but currently includes transactional sex of any pindion

STATS

Estimated 14 billion generated by sex industry in the US each year

9.1 million full service sex workers worldwide

1-2 million estimated in the US

70-80K US arrests each year nationally

16,000 arrests of youth in 2022

361 million in anti-trafficking grants in 2022

Estimated 200 million spent on arrests

70% of arrests involve female sex workers or female managers

Sex work is legal or decriminalized in 86 countries

Most statistics on sex work and sex trafficking are unreliable
